She did not run from My Cross. On the contrary, she embraced it. One arm was extended to the Cross, the other to her Sorrowful, and Immaculate, and Merciful heart. My mother embraced My sacrifice and My suffering. She made it a part of her own. Therefore, she made the Cross part of her life. She knew I was the Savior and that My sacrifice would redeem the world, but she so loved the world and loved Me, that she desired to share in My suffering. Her suffering became My suffering, and My pain her pain, and her pain, Mine. I did not lessen her cross because she knew in her heart that all crosses lead to the Cross of Glory.

Dear little ones, your crosses that you embrace shall lead you, each one of you, to eternal glory. I ask you as I asked My mother to share in My suffering and My sacrifice for the redemption of souls and also for your own redemption and sanctification. It was through My mother's suffering at My Cross that she became your Mother of Mercy. The sword that pierced her heart pierced it so much so that it opened every drop of mercy and love that she has for you. As the sword pierced her heart, so did the spear pierce My heart, and together both of our hearts flood your hearts with grace, mercy, peace, love, and forgiveness.

It is a grace from God to desire and to embrace the Cross. My Cross leads to salvation. The cross I give you to bear will lead you to sanctification and salvation if you do not run from it. My mother embraced every bitter passion because she knew it would open the gate of her mercy to the world and eventually open the gate of My mercy to the world through the piercing of both our hearts.

Come, my little ones and embrace your cross. Embrace My Cross, embrace the ones I give you. There, like My mother, you will be flooded with grace and mercy that came from both our hearts at the foot of the Cross. Stand with My mother. Stand with St. John the Apostle. Stand with Mary Magdalene. Stand and embrace every word and every cross I give you. It is only through the cross that you are led to salvation, and it is only through My Cross that you will receive strength and salvation to carry your cross for your own sanctification and for the conversion of the world. →
